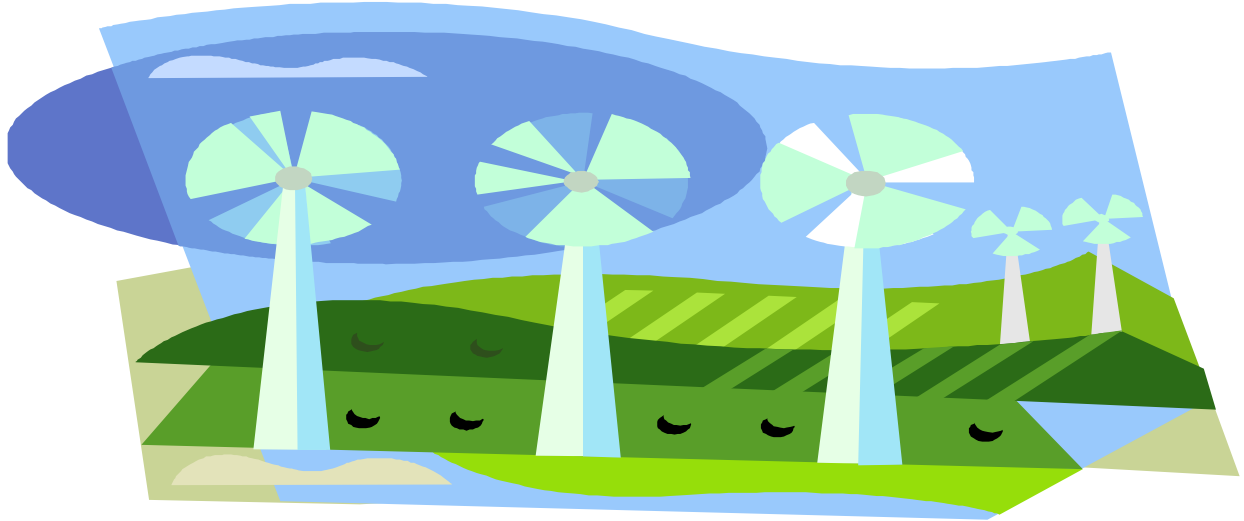


# ENERGY FORUM
